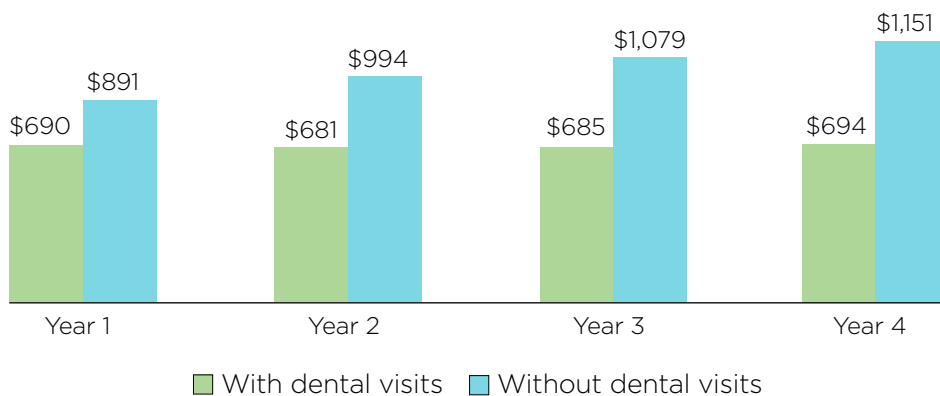


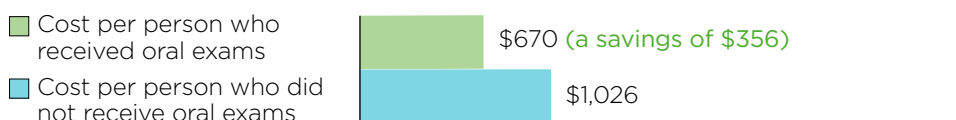
Routine dental care may help you save!

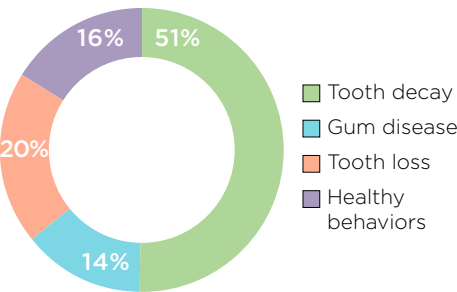

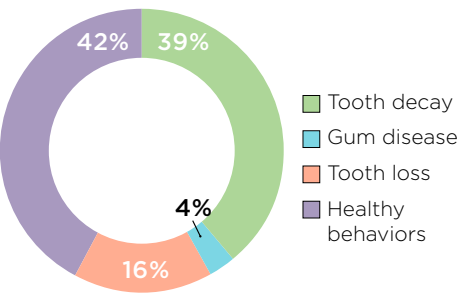
WHAT PROCEDURES ARE DRIVING COSTS?

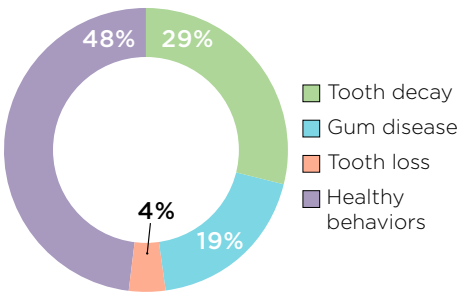
Regular visits



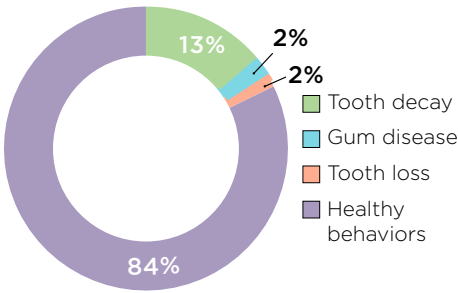
WHAT TYPES OF CARE DO PEOPLE NEED?
